

Is Your Child Starting Kindergarten?



ARE YOUR CHILD'S IMMUNIZATIONS UP TO DATE?


- **Two vaccines are provided free for kindergarten-age children starting at age 4:**
 - The **Tdap-IPV vaccine** to protect against tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis (whooping cough) and polio
 - The **MMRV vaccine** to protect against measles, mumps, rubella and varicella (chickenpox)
- **Call to book your child's immunization appointment today!**
 - Contact your local health unit*
 - Contact your health care provider†

* Health units are called public health units, community health centres or primary care homes in some areas of B.C.

† Family doctors provide immunizations in some areas of B.C. only

Make sure your child's immunizations are up to date. This is one of the most important things you can do to protect their health and the health of their classmates.
